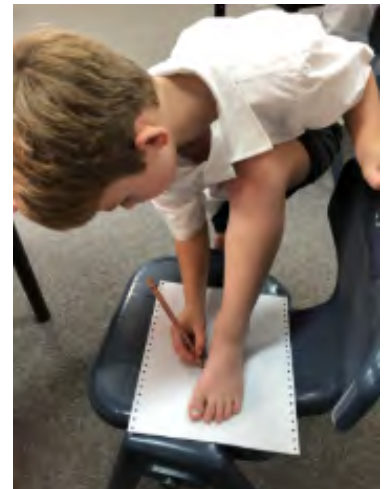
Harry, Wilbur and Lincoln reading a story together in the book corner.
