2019 MID YEAR REPORTS

This year a new report system and structure has been introduced across our Dioceses. **The reports have been created in a new format.** Below is a explanation of how to read your child's report.

5 point scale.

It is a requirement of all schools to report student progression across a common 5 point scale. Our reports reflect this through the descriptors located on the inside cover of the report. The term **standard** has been used to reflect where students are expected to be at this point and stage of their education.

Strands within Subjects

Within the subjects of English and Mathematics, results have been presented against the various strands. For English, these are *Reading and Viewing, Speaking and Listening and Writing and Representing*. In the subject of Mathematics, these are Number and Algebra, Measurement and Geometry and Statistics and Probability.

Comments

The teacher comments refer to the **strengths** that your child displays in that particular subject. A strengths comment has been created for all subjects. Within the subjects of English and Mathematics a **Future Focus Area** comment has been created. This comment reflects some of the targets for learning in the second half of the year. Some of these may be a short term focus while others may be long term

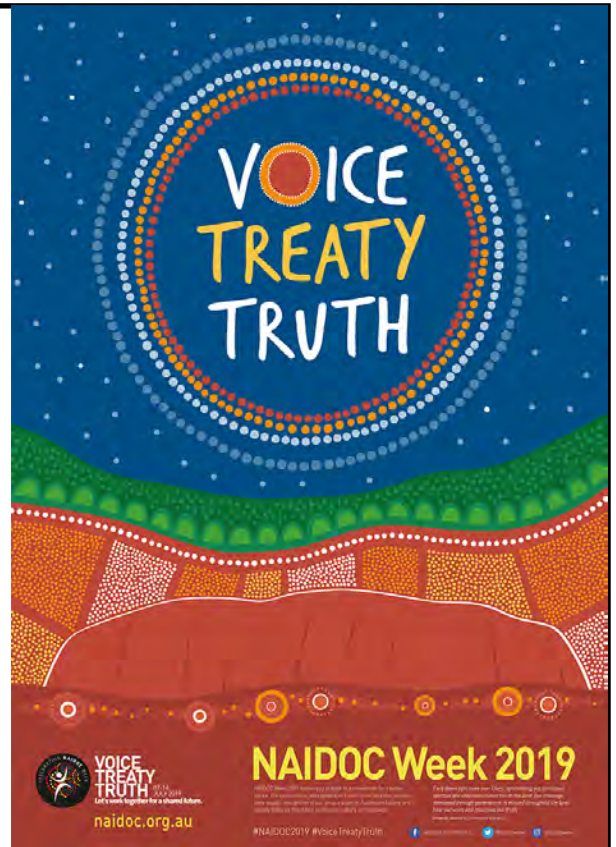
With the release of the **Parent Portal**, reports will become available for families to access online once they are ready to be viewed.
